

# THE PIER PRECINCT STAGE 1

Hervey Bay City Council is upgrading the Urangan Pier Precinct as part of its city-wide program to link improved open space areas with a network of shared pedestrian-cycle pathways and shared pedestrian and slow traffic zones. Roadworks, streetscaping, traffic calming, foreshore revegetation, shade tree planting, upgraded facilities and drainage infrastructure, extensive paving and lighting, play and picnic areas, public art, and outdoor dining venues will provide a high quality and accessible recreational facility for the community, invigorate local businesses through increased visitation, and enhance and interpret Urangan's cultural heritage and beautiful natural environment.

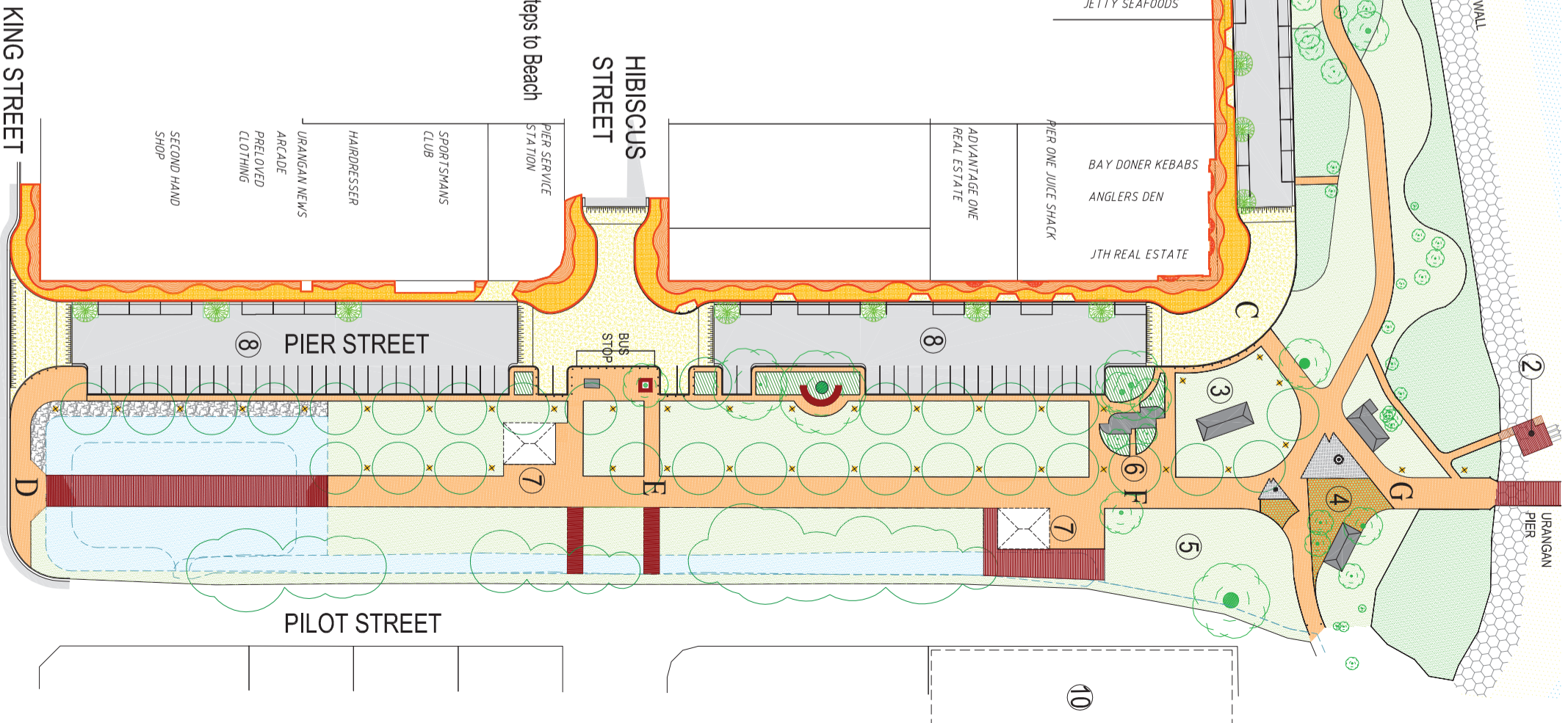
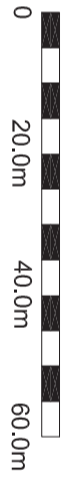
## ORDER OF WORKS
